Witnessing is about building relationships and sharing stories of what God has done for us in a genuine way. Your story is important! Sharing it can change lives.


GENEROSITY

START WITH PRAYER

ANNUAL COMMITMENT CARD

Making a commitment in advance of giving helps Grace's leadership budget wisely. It's important to keep a steady cash flow to keep up with fixed expenses such as utilities and payroll. It's also important for our faith journey to consider giving of the "first fruits" to God, rather than what might be 'left over' at the end of the year.

WORSHIP WITH GRATITUDE

On Consecration Sunday, November 24, we will consecrate our commitments to God during worship. This is an opportunity as a congregation to express our confidence in God's provision and our gratitude for God's blessings.
